Carl “Hoop-D” Haertel was a bartender at the Club Tap, a regular patron, and a dear friend to the CT family. He grew up in the area and lived here all his life. In his late 20’s, he was diagnosed as a diabetic. His health steadily declined over the next decade, and on August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2003 he passed away in his sleep.
